Dear Members,

The City of Greenfield partnered with the Hancock County Drainage Board in February 2018 to start the process of updating the county's storm water ordinance, which is very similar to the ordinance that the City uses. The City storm water ordinance was adopted in 2007 and has not been updated since. There have been many changes to standards and industry standards in that time; this update would help address some of those changes.

Over the course of 2018 progress was made to update the storm water ordinance but due to the extensive nature of the scope changes and added review & comment time, the consultant requires an additional not to exceed amount of \$6,000 to finish the work. This \$6,000 will be split among the 3 units that originally entered into the interlocal in February 2018 and will benefit from the new code: Greenfield, McCordsville, and Hancock County.

I would like to recommend the approval and execution of the attached Interlocal Agreement Amendment with the Hancock County Drainage Board for a not-to-exceed amount of \$2,000 for the storm water ordinance update.

INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT AMENDMENT


Comes now, the Hancock County Drainage, the Board of Works and Public Safety of the City of Greenfield, Indiana enter into an Interlocal Agreement Amendment pursuant to Indiana Code 36-1-7, said amendment to be as follows:

The stormwater management ordinance and technical standards documents to be updated to provide more current standards and requirements, updated fact sheets, optional Low Impact Development and Best Management Practices. The amendment is needed because during the review of the ordinance and technical standards there was a very thorough review which meant more meetings and more time to review and change of the material for local entities. The Hancock County Surveyor will be responsible for paying Christopher B Burke Engineering LLC an additional amount not to exceed \$6,000. The City of Greenfield will each pay to Hancock County an additional amount not to exceed \$2000 for a total of \$6000.




