Miniaturized Red Dot System for Duty Handgun Use	General Order 20-002
---	-----------------------------

PURPOSE:

This policy establishes the authority and guidelines for the implementation of miniaturized red dot system on duty hand gun.

POLICY:

Eligible Personnel will be able to use approved red dot optic on a duty approved handgun. Officers will have to qualify with and without the use of the optic to be eligible to carry an approved handgun with an approved red dot optic while working with the Greenfield Police Department. The approved handgun, red dot optic, and all accessories required will be purchased by the officer. Eligible personnel should understand that if this approved hand gun and optic are used during their capacity as a Police Officer with the Greenfield Police Department, the gun and/or optic can be seized as evidence and will be held until after the investigation.

DEFINITIONS:

Eligible Personnel--For the purpose of this policy all sworn full time and reserve officers are eligible personnel.

Approved hand gun--Glock 17 Generation 5 MOS module with night sights is the approved handgun.

Approved red dot optic--Trijicon RMR RM06 Type 2 3.25 MOA dot with the use of only a Duracell battery will be the approved optic.

Accessories--Safariland Holster 6362 RDS or 6392 RDS are approved holsters, Glock secondary sight kit.

Duty Weapon--For the purpose of the firearms policy this weapon will be considered as your duty weapon.

PROCEDURES

A. General Provisions

1. Any eligible personnel may request to purchase the approved handgun, optic, and accessories. Approval will be at the sole discretion of the Chief or his designee.

2. The Officer will be required to purchase all items, and present all items at the time of qualification.

3. The Officer must be able to proficiently pass the qualification course in the presence of a Greenfield Firearm’s Instructor with a qualifying score with and without the use of the red dot optic.

4. It is the Officer’s responsibility to make arraignments with a Greenfield Firearms Instructor quarterly to check the sights zero and change the battery at least twice a year. This can be done sooner if needed.

5. It is the Officer’s responsibility to maintain the firearm, accessories and red dot optic scope. If an officer is found to be negligent in maintaining the firearm, accessories, and red dot optic scope. The officer will not be eligible to carry the weapon or the optic on or off duty and be covered by the Greenfield Police Department.

6. The officer will be cooperative in letting a Greenfield Firearms Instructor inspect the weapon and/or scope at any reasonable time as the Greenfield Police Department will be responsible for annual maintenance of the firearm.
