Greenfield Board of Works and Public Safety

As you are well aware, the Greenfield Police Department recently upgraded to the new in-car/body worn camera system. In an effort to provide another layer of security and safety for the officers on the street, we have been experimenting with adding cellular coverage to each body worn camera. This technology will provide real-time data of the officer's location and the ability to live-stream at any given time while away from his/her car.

This addition to the platform has been challenging as we monitor data usage for each device while keeping the cost at a minimum. We have been working with Verizon who is our current data provider and experimenting with AT&T FirstNet over the past few weeks to determine which provider best serves our needs and budget.

Prior to the new camera system our data package through Verizon has been averaging at approximately \$1,900 monthly. Verizon has provided an estimate to include the additional data package for the body cameras at \$2309.41 per month.

Our trial run with AT&T has been successful and they have provided an estimate of \$2158.41 per month with slightly more data included. Additionally, if we switch to AT&T, our payments will be deferred for 3.82 months due to current promotional credits.

I am requesting the Board to approve the AT&T FirstNet State of Indiana Participation agreement and switching our data service provider to AT&T FirstNet.
