### **APPROVAL OF MINUTES:**

A motion to approve the September 12nd, 2018 meeting minutes as presented was made by Councilman Skvarenina and duly seconded by Councilman Riley. Motion carried *viva voce*.

Councilman Skvarenina provided a report on the funding which has been raised for the Lizabuth Anne Kitchen project. They are now at \$185,000.

### **NEW BUSINESS:**

Attorney Morelock presented the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement for the Center Township Trustee plans to re-locate their offices to Fire Station 2 and will contribute \$300.00 per month toward expenses. This agreement has already been approved by the Board of Works and the approval of the Council is also requested on the Agreement. Councilman Grass moved to approve the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement as presented, duly seconded by Councilman McDaniel. Motion Carried *viva voce*.

**Ordinance 2018-15**                    **An Ordinance Amending Title VII, Chapter 74, Schedules I, II and VI of the Code of Ordinance of the City of Greenfield, Indiana;** on first reading as introduced by Attorney Morelock. Councilman McDaniel moved to approve Ordinance 2018-15 as presented, duly seconded by Councilman Skvarenina. Motion Carried *viva voce*.

**Ordinance 2018-16**                    **An Ordinance Amending Title 52, Regarding Operation and Administration of the Greenfield Water Utility;** on first reading as introduced by Attorney Morelock. Councilman Grass moved to approve Ordinance 2018- as presented, duly seconded by Councilman Riley. Motion Carried *viva voce*.

**MISCELLANEOUS BUSINESS:**

**Robert Workman**, Commander in Chief for the Honor Guard and he is also the VA Officer here in Hancock County, was present to address the members of the Council with a request for funds to allow the purchase of a new van for the use of the Veteran's Honor Guard, Inc. This will allow them to transport Veterans to the VA hospital as well as free up time for the Senior Services as well by transporting local Veterans who need assistance in getting to their appointments in Indianapolis. It is their intention to purchase a larger van which will allow them to transport multiple Veterans. They would also receive matching funds from the Department of Veteran's Services. There is no administration fee making 100% of the funds would go to the request.

Councilman Riley stated that he had reviewed their documents during the grant process and all is in order. Mr. Workman mentioned that all major donors name will be featured on the side of the vehicle. Councilman Skvarenina moved to set aside the amount of \$5,000 for this request, duly seconded by Councilman McDaniel. The funds would come from the CEDIT Fund. Motion carried *viva voce*.
