A motion to approve the November 14th, 2018 meeting minutes as presented was made by Councilman Skvarenina and duly seconded by Councilman Grass. Motion carried *viva voce*.

Ordinance 2018 – 22 **An Ordinance Amending the Park Non-Reverting Fund;** on third and final reading and eligible for final adoption by the Common Council. Councilman Grass motioned to approve Ordinance 2018-22 as presented on third reading, seconded by Councilman Riley. Mayor Fewell called for a roll call vote by Clerk-Treasurer Elmore. AYES: Councilman Butrum, Lowder, McDaniel, Riley, Skvarenina and Grass. Nayes: None. Ordinance 2018-22 was declared approved by 6 to 0 vote.

Deputy Chief of Police Matt Holland addressed the members of the Council regarding a matching grant which has been awarded to the Greenfield Police Department for the purchase of vests. Questions and discussion followed.

Ron Pritzke of Pritzke & Davis and **Bill Huffman** of Photon Holdings, LLC addressed the members of the Council regarding a tax-abatement request.

Resolution 2018 - 13 **A Preliminary Declaratory Resolution Designating an Economic Revitalization Area and Approving Tax Abatement;** Councilman Grass motioned to approve Resolution 2018-13 as presented, seconded by Councilman McDaniel. Mayor Fewell called for a roll call vote by Clerk-Treasurer Elmore AYES: Councilman Butrum, Lowder, McDaniel, Riley, Skvarenina and Grass. Nayes: None. Resolution 2018-13 was declared approved by a 6 to 0 vote.

Ordinance 2018 – 23 **An Ordinance Authorizing Additional Appropriations for the GO FIRE BOND;** on first reading as introduced by Attorney Morelock. Councilman Grass motioned to approve Ordinance 2018-23 as presented, duly seconded by Councilman Riley. Motion Carried *viva voce*.
