

ORDINANCE NO. 2019 – 1

**ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RATES AND CHARGES FOR
ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING STATIONS**

WHEREAS, the Greenfield Municipal Power and Light Utility is nearing completion of the installation of two (2) charging stations for electric vehicles for use by the public; and

WHEREAS, the charging stations will utilize the services of an entity known as ChargePoint, Inc., who will operate the charging stations and charge the customer a fee for such services at the rate established by the City of Greenfield, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held before the Common Council of the City of Greenfield, Indiana, on the _____ day of January, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Greenfield, Indiana, believes that installation of electric charging stations is in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Greenfield, Indiana, and the establishment of a rate for electricity utilization associated with the charging station is necessary for the proper management of such facilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENFIELD, INDIANA:

SECTION I

There shall be added to Title 5 within the Code of Ordinances for the City of Greenfield, Indiana, a new subsection 50.080 entitled Electric Vehicle Charging Station Rate to read as follows:

Electric Vehicle Charging Station

§ 50.080 AVAILABILITY.

Charging stations for electric vehicles shall be available to any member of the public for continuous year-round service to members of the public and designated locations.

§ 50.081 CHARACTER OF SERVICE.

Electric vehicle charging stations shall be available to members of the public 24 hours per day for each day of the year.

§ 50.082 RATE.

The base charge immediately upon connection to the charging station by the electric vehicle shall be in the amount of Two Dollars (\$2.00). Thereafter, the rate for utilization of the Electric Vehicle Charging Station facilities shall be \$0.50 per hour.

SECTION II

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval by the Mayor, and publication as prescribed by law.

Upon a motion to approve the above on third reading was offered and sustained by a vote of _____ in favor and _____ opposed pursuant to I.C. 36-5-2-9.8.
