APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

A motion to approve the January 23rd, 2019 meeting minutes as presented was made by Councilman Grass, and duly seconded by Councilman Lowder. Motion carried *viva voce*.

REPORTS FROM COMMITTEES, BOARDS and COMMISSIONS:

Councilman Riley reported that he had attended the Exit Interview with the State Board of Accounts this week for the audit on the financials of the City for the years 2016 and 2017. He was happy to report that the Audit for both years was a clean audit with no comments, adjustments or findings in either year. He commended the Clerk-Treasurer, Lori Elmore, on this achievement.

Clerk-Treasurer Lori Elmore thanked Councilman Riley for his comments and acknowledged that the positive results came from the team effort of those in her office. The other members of her team included the dedicated work of Chief Deputy Tracy Walter, Deputy Anne Noack and Deputy Jennifer Frye who also worked in the Clerk-Treasurers office during the time frame of the financial audit.

Councilman McDaniel provided an update on the number of permits which have been given this year to date.

Councilman Skvarenina provided an update on the fundraising project for Li 'buth Anne's Kitchen. Their goal has been met!

Councilman Skvarenina also provided an update on the Traffic Safety Committee meeting.

NEW BUSINESS:

Members of the Matchbook Creative team presented a slide show of the proposed website they were creating. The website is still several weeks away from being completed. Discussion followed by several of the Council members and the Mayor asking questions. Questions regarding the photographs that would be included in the finished product, the possibility of a link to the 'Hello Hancock' website, media buy options for people who are advertising on the website as well as the possibility of emails

being sent to subscribers of upcoming events, how frequently the sight would be maintained for Facebook and Instagram were posed to the members of the Matchbook Creative team and answered.

Further discussion followed.

The contract for the first year of design work has come to an end. The contracts for a second and third year option which would maintain the website as well as the social media maintenance is with the Board of Works and have not yet been approved.
