APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

A motion to approve the February 27, 2019 meeting minutes as presented was made by Councilman Skvarenina and duly seconded by Councilman McDaniel. Motion carried *viva voce*.

REPORTS FROM COMMITTEES, BOARDS AND COMISSIONS:

Councilman McDaniel provided an update on permits. There were 29 total permits this month 11 were single family dwellings and 2 commercial. 47 total for the year.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

Ordinance 2019 – 6 An Ordinance Amending the Zoning Code of Greenfield, Indiana; on second reading as introduced by Attorney Morelock. Councilman Skvarenina motioned to approve Ordinance 2019-6 as presented, duly seconded by Councilman McDaniel. Motion carried *viva voce*.

Ordinance 2019 – 6 An Ordinance Amending the Zoning Code of Greenfield, Indiana; on third and final reading and eligible for adoption. Councilman Grass motioned to approve Ordinance 2019-6 as presented on third reading, seconded by Councilman Lowder. Mayor Fewell called for a roll call vote by Deputy Clerk-Treasurer Walter. AYES: Councilman Butrum, Grass, Lowder, McDaniel, Pendlum, Skvarenina. Nayes: None. Ordinance 2019-6 was declared approved by 6 to 0 vote.

NEW BUSINESS:

Ordinance 2019 – 7 An Ordinance Appropriating Funds in the Local Option Income Tax Fund for Police Vehicles; on first reading as introduced by Attorney Morelock for the Common Council. Councilman Grass motioned to approve Ordinance 2019-7 as presented, duly seconded by Councilman McDaniel. Motion carried *viva voce*.

Ordinance 2019 – 8 An Ordinance Creating Non-Reverting Fund 266 for the Matching BVP Grant Fund to purchase vests; on first reading as introduced by Attorney Morelock for the Common Council. Councilman Grass motioned to approve Ordinance 2019-8 as presented, duly seconded by Councilman Butrum. Motion carried *viva voce*.

Resolution 2019 – 3 A Resolution Authorizing Purchase of Real Estate; on first reading as introduced by Attorney Morelock for the Common Council. Councilman Skvarenina posed a question and Mike Fruth came forward to clarify the purchase. Councilman Pendlum motioned to approve Resolution 2019-3 as presented, duly seconded by Councilman Lowder. Mayor Fewell called for a roll call vote by Deputy Clerk-Treasurer Walter. AYES: Councilman Butrum, Grass, Lowder, McDaniel, Pendlum, Skvarenina. Naves: None. Resolution 2019-3 was declared approved by 6 to 0 vote.

PETITION OR COMMENTS OF CITIZENS:

A citizen raised his hand to approach with comments. Mayor Fewell stated that the only things that were up for discussion is what was on the current agenda for the evening. Citizen declined approaching to comment.
