RESOLUTION REGARDING THE TRANSFER OF PERSONAL PROPERTY

WHEREAS, the Town of Cumberland, Indiana, possesses a 2006 Monico Trailer, VIN: 1KB131L256E159385; and

WHEREAS, the Cumberland Police Department used this trailer for various police purposes but it is no longer needed by the Town and it is no longer fit for its intended purpose; and

WHEREAS, the City of Greenfield, by and through the Chief of the Greenfield Police Department, has expressed an interest in obtaining the trailer, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Indiana Code § 36-1-11-8, the Town of Cumberland the City of Greenfield agree that the Town of Cumberland will transfer the trailer to the City of Greenfield in exchange for \$500.00; and

WHEREAS, before transfer can be completed, both the City of Greenfield and the Town of Cumberland must pass a substantially similar resolution detailing the terms of this exchange; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Cumberland has agreed to transfer the trailer, title to the trailer, and all other necessary documentation to the City of Greenfield within 30 days after the adoption of this Resolution by both parties.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Common Council of the City of Greenfield, Indiana, that the Town of Cumberland shall transfer the 2006 Monico Trailer, VIN: 1KB131L256E159385 to the City of Greenfield in exchange for \$500.00 and pursuant to the terms and conditions described herein.
