APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

A motion to approve the June 12th, 2019 meeting minutes as presented was made by Councilman Lowder and duly seconded by Councilman Riley. Motion carried *viva voce*.

REPORTS FROM COMMITTEES, BOARDS AND COMISSIONS:

Councilman Butrum informed the members of the Council that she had spoken with Councilman Riley and planned to look into any changes in the rules and regulations of bee keeping which were coming into effect as of July 1st in terms of the location and quantity of hives which are allowed within City limits.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

Public Hearing on Ordinance 2019-12 – Ordinance Vacating Certain Easements

Councilman Lowder motioned to approve Ordinance 2019-12 on third reading, duly seconded by Councilman Grass. Mayor Fewell called for a roll call vote by Clerk-Treasurer Elmore AYES: Councilman Butrum, Grass, Lowder, McDaniel, Pendlum, Skvarenina and Riley. Nays: None. Ordinance 2019-12 was declared approved by a vote of 7 to 0.

NEW BUSINESS:

No new business was discussed.

MISCELLANEOUS BUSINESS:

Mayor Fewell mentioned there had been discussion of the grass cuttings being blown into the street. In some areas this has become an issue that needed to be addressed. Councilman Riley said he would look into this situation and see what might be done to eliminate this issue.
