**APPROVAL OF MINUTES:**

A motion to approve the June 26th, 2019 meeting minutes as presented was made by Councilman Grass and duly seconded by Councilman Riley. Motion Carried *viva voce*.

**REPORTS FROM COMMITTEES, BOARDS AND COMISSIONS:**

Councilman McDaniel provided a report of the number of permits which have been issued year to date.

**Ordinance 2019 – 13 An Ordinance Amending the Parks and Recreation Pool Concession Petty Cash Change Fund;** on first reading as introduced by Attorney Morelock. Councilman Riley moved to approve Ordinance 2019-13 as presented, duly seconded by Councilman Grass. Motion Carried *viva voce*.

**Ordinance 2019 – 13 An Ordinance Amending the Parks and Recreation Pool Concession Petty Cash Change Fund;** on second reading as introduced by Attorney Morelock. Councilman McDaniel moved to approve Ordinance 2019-13 as presented, duly seconded by Councilman Skvarenina. Motion Carried *viva voce*.

**Ordinance 2019 – 13 An Ordinance Amending the Parks and Recreation Pool Concession Petty Cash Change Fund;** on third and final reading and eligible for final adoption by the Common Council. Councilman Grass moved to approve Ordinance 2019-13 on third reading, duly seconded by Councilman McDaniel. Mayor Fewell called for a roll call vote by Clerk-Treasurer Elmore AYES: Councilman Butrum, Grass, McDaniel, Skvarenina and Riley. Nays: None. Ordinance 2019-13 was declared approved by a vote of 5 to 0.
