A motion to approve the August 14, 2019 meeting minutes as presented was made by Councilman Grass and duly seconded by Councilman Lowder. Motion carried *viva voce*.

REPORTS FROM COMMITTEES, BOARDS AND COMISSIONS:

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

Ordinance 2019 – 14 An Ordinance Authorizing Additional Appropriations for the Police Department for Weather Warning Sirens; on second reading as introduced by Attorney Isom. Councilman Grass motioned to approve Ordinance 2019-14 as presented, duly seconded by Councilman McDaniel. Motion carried *viva voce*.

Ordinance 2019 – 14 An Ordinance Authorizing Additional Appropriations for the Police Department for Weather Warning Sirens; on third and final reading and eligible for adoption. Councilman McDaniel motioned to approve Ordinance 2019-14 as presented on third reading, seconded by Councilman Grass. Dan Riley called for a roll call vote by Deputy Clerk-Treasurer Walter. Ordinance 2019 – 15 An Ordinance Renaming the State Seizure Fund to the Non-Reverting Law Enforcement Fund and Creating the Non-Reverting Department of Treasury Equitable Sharing Fund Identified as the Homeland Security Investigation Fund; on second reading as introduced by Attorney Isom. Councilman Lowder motioned to approve Ordinance 2019-15 as presented, duly seconded by Councilman Grass. Motion carried *viva voce*.

Ordinance 2019 – 15 An Ordinance Renaming the State Seizure Fund to the Non-Reverting Law Enforcement Fund and Creating the Non-Reverting Department of Treasury Equitable Sharing Fund Identified as the Homeland Security Investigation Fund; on third and final reading and eligible for adoption. Councilman Grass motioned to approve Ordinance 2019-15 as presented on third reading, seconded by Councilman Lowder. Dan Riley called for a roll call vote by Deputy Clerk-Treasurer Walter. AYES: Councilman Butrum, Grass, Lowder, McDaniel, Riley, Skvarenina. Nays: None. Ordinance 2019-15 was declared approved by 6 to 0 vote.

NEW BUSINESS:

Ordinance 2019-16 An Ordinance Amending Title VII, Chapter 74, Schedules I and IX of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Greenfield; on first reading as introduced by Attorney Isom for the Common Council. Councilman McDaniel motioned to approve Ordinance 2019-16 as presented, duly seconded by Councilman Skvarenina. Motion carried *viva voce*.

Dan Riley moved that there being no further business to be brought before the Greenfield Common Council, Councilman McDaniel moved to adjourn the meeting at 7:08 p.m., duly seconded by Councilman Lowder. Motion carried *viva voce*.
