Notice is hereby given to taxpayers of **GREENFIELD CIVIL CITY, Hancock County**, Indiana that the proper officers of **Greenfield Civil City** will conduct a public hearing on the year **2021** budget. Following this meeting, any ten or more taxpayers may object to a budget, tax rate, or tax levy by filing an objection petition with the proper officers of **Greenfield Civil City** not more than seven days after the hearing. The objection petition must identify the provisions of the budget, tax rate, or tax levy to which taxpayers object. If a petition is filed, **Greenfield Civil City** shall adopt with the budget a finding concerning the objections in the petition and testimony presented. Following the aforementioned hearing, the proper officers of **Greenfield Civil City** will meet to adopt the following budget:
